**Summary of Job Duties and Responsibilities** the Watershed Natural Resource Intern assists with the development, collection; and analysis of various monitoring data; conducts aquatic and terrestrial biotic and abiotic sampling; assist in lab procedures; works on special projects, assist with field evaluations; conducts routine inspections; performs other essential duties as deemed necessary.

**Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities**

Ability to follow oral and written instructions.  
Ability to follow protocols and have good problem-solving skills.  
Exposure to or experience with analytical instruments and/or field and laboratory equipment  
Ability to perform laboratory testing and analysis.  
Ability to maintain accurate records with close attention to detail.  
Ability to read maps and basic plans.  
Ability to work outside in all types of weather/terrain.  
Ability to work around water and swim.  
Ability to perform work in remote locations with only minimal supervision.  
Ability to prepare professional reports summarizing biological and chemical data in a timely manner.

Must have completed two years of study toward bachelor's degree in Biology, Natural Resources, Wildlife and Fisheries, Geography, Limnology, Environmental Science or a related field  
Must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program OR be no more than two semesters removed from a program (graduates of Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 are eligible).  
GPA 2.5 or above  
Valid driver's license with good driving record and reliable transportation for occasional use on the job

**Preferred Qualifications**

Prefer students with an interest in water quality/water resource/natural resource issues.  
Prefer experience with GPS and/or GIS.

**Special Qualifications**

Must pass a criminal background check.  
Must be a high-performing, innovative, values-driven, informed, and passionate individual.

**Work Conditions**

Individual will work in a combination of outdoor and indoor environments. Outside work will be conducted in all types of weather and the intern may be exposed to extreme heat, rain, sun, etc. Works in forested areas with various terrains and in aquatic habitats. Exposed to dirt, mud, water, etc., on a continuous basis. May be exposed to insects, snakes, dogs, poison ivy and other potentially hazardous plants and animals.
