

SPRING SEMESTER APPLICANTS STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING ANNUAL VACATION

The following information applies to all prospective students who:

- will enter the U.S. on an F-1 student visa for the first time for the Spring semester (January – May) and
- were not enrolled in on-campus courses at another institution on an F-1 student visa in the previous Fall semester (August-December).

F-1 students are eligible to take an annual vacation after completing a full <u>academic year of study in the United States</u>. An academic year for undergraduate students is defined as 30 instructional weeks and completion of 24 credit hours. Students who begin study on their F-1 visa in the Spring semester will have only completed 15 weeks of the required 30 weeks of study at the end of the semester and are **not** eligible for an annual vacation for the entire summer (May to August). Undergraduate students who begin their F-1 visa in January are required to enroll in 6 credit hours over the summer and enroll in the following Fall semester. Please note that the majority of classes are offered in June-July (Summer I session) and July-August (Summer II session). Graduate students who begin their program in January are required to enroll full time in the summer (normally 3-6 credits hours depending upon program) and enroll in the following Fall semester.

By signing below, I understand that I will be required to enroll in the appropriate number of credit hours on campus in the first summer I am studying at UCA. Failure to do so will result in termination of my immigration record.
