SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS *

International Student Merit Scholarship: Awarded for up to 8 consecutive semesters or completion of a bachelor's degree to eligible first-time degree-seeking international students beginning an undergraduate program of study at UCA. The scholarship award is \$2,000 per semester for a maximum award of \$16,000. Fall & spring semesters only. **Deadline: March 31st.**

Out of State Tuition Scholarship: All international students who live in campus housing, receive an automatic scholarship equivalent to the out-of-state tuition charges (approximately \$7,200 for 15 credit hours in Fall 2022).

Global Citizen Scholarship: Exclusively for international students already enrolled at UCA. Award equivalent to full tuition and fees for 12 undergraduate credit hours for one academic year. Approximately \$8,400 for fall and spring semesters only. **Deadline: May 1st.**

WHY CHOOSE UCA?

Founded in 1907, the University of Central Arkansas ranks among the best Public Universities in the South according to U.S. News & World Report.

The University of Central Arkansas has more than 10,000 students, 385 of whom come from 79 different countries. With a faculty to student ratio of 16 to 1, students can choose from 162 different degree options, ranging from 90 undergraduate, 11 graduate certificates, 34 masters, 11 post-masters certificates, and 7 doctoral programs.

Undergraduate Admissions Criteria

- **Transcripts/mark sheets** from secondary school with a minimum GPA of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale
- **SAT/ACT scores not required**, but may fulfill English proficiency. Scores should be sent by the testing agency. UCA school code for the ACT--0118; for the SAT--6012
- \$50 non-refundable **application fee**
- **Copy of diploma** or leaving certificate or GED (General Education Diploma) translated into English
- **English Proficiency:** TOEFL iBT 61, IELTS 6.0
- **Financial support statement**
- **NO BGCSE scores required for admission**

Fall (Aug. – Dec.): July 1

Spring (Jan. – May): November 1

Summer (June – August): April 15

INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

The Intensive English Program (IEP) has a six-level program with courses in all skills to prepare students for academic success in their undergraduate studies. Each session is eight weeks during the academic year and five weeks in the summer. Upon successful completion of IEP classes, students begin credit-bearing courses towards their degree. No TOEFL, IELTS, SAT, or ACT is required to enter or complete the Intensive English program. Students who place in our Pathway program may take a limited number of content courses while studying English.

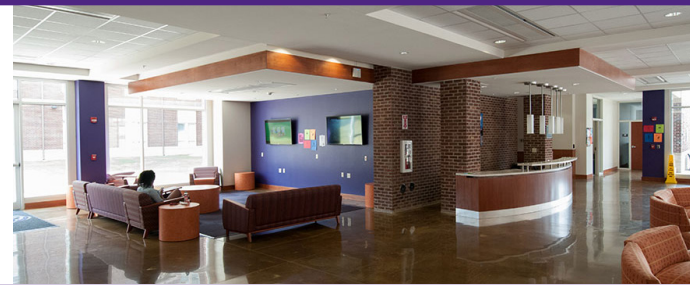
