The University of Central Arkansas has more than 10,000 students, 385 of whom come from 79 different countries. Undergraduate Admissions Criteria

- **Transcripts/mark sheets** from secondary school with a minimum GPA of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale
- **SAT/ACT scores not required**, but may fulfill English proficiency.
- \$50 non-refundable **application fee**
- **Copy of diploma** or leaving certificate or GED (General Education Diploma) translated into English
- **English Proficiency:** TOEFL iBT 61, IELTS 6.0
- **Financial support statement**
- **NO GCSE scores required for admission**
- **Nigeria and Ghana:**
 - Scratch Card
 - WAEC Certificate

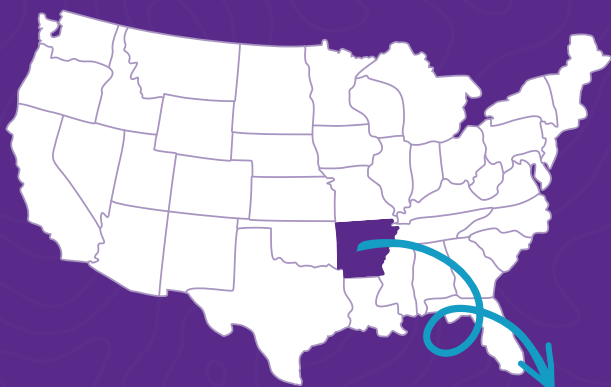
