
Course Information

All undergraduate classes in above listed areas are open to exchanges provided that students are proficient in the English language and prerequisites to upper-level courses have been fulfilled.

The first digit indicates the level of the course:

- 1000: courses designed for beginning students
- 2000: second-level courses, higher level of sophistication
- 3000: third-level courses designed for second, third or fourth year university students
- 4000: most complex undergraduate courses designed for third and fourth year students
- 5000 & higher: graduate courses open only to students admitted to graduate-level study

Arrival Information	A university shuttle will be available for airport pick-ups and drop-offs at the beginning and end of the semester for stated dates and times. More information will be made available after the student is admitted.
Student Credentials	Upon acceptance to UCA, students will receive login information to their MyUCA account (https://my.uca.edu/) and university email. Students are encouraged to check their UCA email regularly, even prior to arrival. Exchange students will receive a digital UCA Bear Card (university identification card) upon arrival. This student ID will be set up on a mobile device and used to pay for on-campus meals, enter housing and other on-campus buildings, allow the student to attend some programs and sporting events free of charge, give discounts at participating businesses and more.
