## **English Language Requirement Exempt Countries:**

Students whose first language is English and who graduated from a secondary school or university where English was the language of instruction in one of the exempt countries below <u>are not</u> required to submit proof of English proficiency.

Students from countries not on this list whose first language is English and who graduated from a secondary school or university where English was the language of instruction <u>may</u> petition for an exemption.

NB: all students who do not submit an ACT or SAT score are required to take an Accuplacer exam upon arriving on campus to determine need for remediation in math, reading, or writing.
