## LIBRARY

Torreyson Library provides both research and recreational reading materials. Research coaches are available to help graduate students with projects. The library provides seating for more than 1,000 people in a variety of settings, from individual study carrels to group study rooms, and is open 7 days a week with limited weekend hours. The library's collection includes almost 1 million titles in a variety of physical and electronic formats. Interlibrary loan services give you access to resources in other collections. In addition to two computer labs with 60 desktop computers, 4 b/w networked printers, 1 color networked printer, three copiers, five scanners, and one overhead book scanner. In addition, the library circulates 50 laptop computers.
