- (2) Praxis I passing scores;
- (3) Technology Competency exam or acceptable technology course;
- (4) two undergraduate writing classes, oral communication, a math class equivalent to Math 1360 or above with grades of C or better;
- (5) two faculty recommendations;
- (6) admission interview with history department faculty.

Application for Program Admission including registration for faculty interview must be completed by

OCT 1 for Fall or MARCH 1 for Spring.
