Requirements for graduation with honors are as follows: (1) a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.25 and a 3.50 grade point average in the major; (2) successful completion of HIST 4313 Department Honors Thesis Research and HIST 4314 Department Honors Thesis Writing; (3) submission and approval of an Honors Thesis.
