**PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:** Prior to enrollment in HIST 4310 and HIST 4351, students must meet the PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS [this coincides with **GATE 2**]. They are as follows:

- (1) A minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA on all coursework attempted; transfer and Post BAC students must have a cumulative 2.75 GPA on all coursework attempted and must have established a 2.75 on at least 12 semester hours at UCA;
- (2) MATH 1390, oral communication, and two undergraduate writing classes with grades of C or better in each;
- (3) A minimum 2.75 GPA for all HIST and social studies content courses attempted;
- (4) A grade of C or better in all HIST and social studies content courses attempted;
- (5) two faculty recommendations; and
- (6) an admission interview with history department faculty.

Application for Program Admission including registration for faculty interview must be completed by OCT 1 for Fall or MARCH 1 for Spring.

All content and pedagogy courses must be completed and *Praxis 5581 Social Studies: Content & Knowledge must be taken before* or during Internship I (as of September 2024). The minimum score for licensing is 141. Students failing to meet that score of 141 are not eligible for Internship II. \*NOTE\* - Praxis 5081 (effective September 2022 – September 2024) certified 7-12 Social Studies – Students failing to meet a minimum score of 145 are not eligible for Internship II. The minimum score for licensing if Praxis 5081 was taken is 155.

## Program Requirements for Graduation with the B.S.E. Degree in Social Studies, History Emphasis

- (1) Degree requires 120 hours, which includes all required courses and an additional two elective hours
- (2) No grade below C accepted in major required courses (this includes HIST courses, social studies content courses, and major requirements as dictated by the College of Education)
- (3) Minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA in all course work
- (4) Minimum 2.75 GPA in all social studies content courses attempted (before and after admission into Program)
- (5) Minimum 2.75 GPA in all minor courses
