Garnishments & Wage Withholding Orders

Garnishments and government wage withholding orders are involuntary deductions where the employer is required by law to deduct a certain amount of the employee's pay and remit it to a person or government agency to satisfy the employee's debt. The employee may be subject to deductions for child support, unpaid taxes or repayment of a debt.

University of Central Arkansas is required by law to accept and process garnishments served by officials of the court. Failure to meet these financial obligations may cause the University to be subject to penalties, plus possible fines and interest.

Once the garnishment or wage order is forwarded to our payroll processor, they enter the information into the payroll-processing database to begin or end a wage order.
