

Adding a Kaltura Video to a Blackboard Course

Media Gallery

You can include the Media Gallery as a link on the Course Menu of your Blackboard course. When you publish a video from My Media to your Blackboard course, the video will be accessible by clicking the link on the Course Menu. Any and all videos published to the course will be listed and accessible to enrolled students.

Content Area

Many instructors require students to watch a specific video and want to include that within the content area of the Blackboard course. In this case, students are going to the content area anyway to access class materials, assignments, and/or tests. Including videos here will keep all required materials and tasks together and in the correct order.

Adding a Kaltura Video to a Content Area

- Click the **Build Content** button and select **Item**.
- **Name** the Item
- In the text editor box type the information you want to include.
- Click **Mashups** and **Kaltura Media**.
- Locate the video you want to include and click **Select**. The video is added to the text editor box as a yellow box.
- Add file attachments, if required, and determine additional options.
- Click **Submit**.

Create Item
A content item is any type of file, text, image, or link that appears to users in a Content Area, Learning Module, Lesson Plan, or content folder. [More Help](#)


