**ELECTIVES ARE CHOSEN FROM THE FOLLOWING COURSES**

In consultation with an advisor, students select three elective courses (nine hours), including at least one course outside of Marketing and Management. The courses will consist of 3000- and 4000-level courses from the traditional business disciplines of Accounting, Marketing, Management, Insurance and Risk Management, Finance, Economics, Management Information Systems, and Quantitative Methods. Student should also be aware of internship opportunities in several of the aforementioned disciplines. Students should consider classes that complement their specific innovation and entrepreneurship interests.

Students will be encouraged to present their work at public or scholarly venues at the completion of the minor.

**NOTE:** A grade point average of 2.0 is required in the minor.
