#### Deadline: at least three weeks before graduation.

#### **Required items include:**

- 1. Cover page with student's name and ID number
- 2. Resume: Updated resume and proof of posting (screenshot or snip) to one of the following forums
  - a. AAFCS Professional Development Center → Create a Job Seeker Account OR Post an Anonymous Resume
  - b. LinkedIn
  - c. Indeed
- 3. References: List of confirmed references (3) with all appropriate contact information (name, credentials, title, address, phone, email)
- 4. Goals: Short-term professional goals (2), long-term professional goals (2), bucket list (dream jobs)
- 5. Professional philosophy statement (see below)
- 6. Professional membership cards (photocopies of cards, e.g. AND, AAFCS, ASID, etc). Just one is sufficient, but include all that are on your resume.
- 7. Business card: Photocopy of your current business card or a design for your dream job business card.
- 8. Professional social media profile: Create profile on LinkedIn and connect with Department Chair, preceptors and others as appropriate
- 9. Samples of professional work—must include at least two samples from this graduate program, examples include:
  - a. Papers
  - b. Budget plans
  - c. Community needs assessment
  - d. Research projects
  - e. Layout and design projects
  - f. Community nutrition client resource report
  - g. Case Study
  - h. Lesson plans
  - i. Program evaluation plan
  - j. Resource management plan

### **Grading Criteria: 44 points**

Students must earn at least 40 points on this assignment. In the event the minimum number points is not earned, the student must revise and resubmit. Delay in production of quality work may delay the graduation application process.
