- Breadth Requirements:
  - **\*Fine Arts and \*Humanities**: Students must take at least one course in the Fine Arts<sup>+</sup> (FA) and one in the Humanities<sup>\*</sup> (HUM) to fulfill lower-division (LD) requirements.
  - **\*Social Science**: All students are required to take six credits of social science. In addition to the SS category, one must be taken in either Diversity in World Cultures or Responsible living category.
  - **First-Year Seminar**^: During the first year, one course from the Critical Inquiry, Diversity, or Responsible Living category must be a First-Year Seminar (FYS). See the online class schedule to find FYS sections.
