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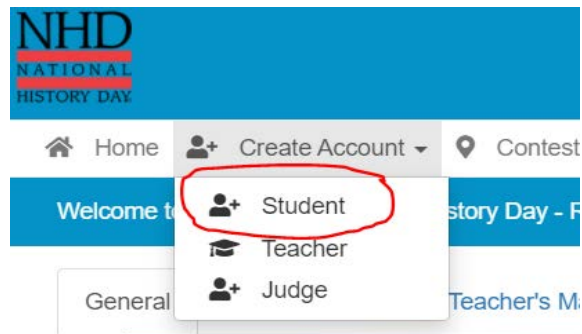
Creating a Student Account

Important: You will not be able to create your account until after your teacher creates their account.

Also Important: The registration deadline is *Friday, Feb. 5 at 11:01 pm.*

Step 1: Go to the regional contest URL: <https://ar-r5.nhd.org/>

Step 2: Click **Create Account** in the toolbar. Select **Student** from the drop-down menu.



Step 3: Insert your first name, last name, and email address. Click the checkbox next to **I am Not a Robot**. Then, click the blue **Next** button.

- o **Note:** This is the email your contest admin will use to contact you.

Step 4: Complete the **Student's Personal Information** section. Then, click the blue **Save & Continue** button. *Be sure to indicate your t-shirt size. All students participating in a regional contest will receive a free NHD t-shirt!*

Step 5: Complete the **Student's School & Teacher section**. Then, click the blue **Save & Continue** button. *It's ok to only add only one teacher.*

Group Project Registration

IF YOU ARE REGISTERING AS PART OF A GROUP PROJECT

- The first student in a group to register will create the entry. That student will give other group members the “Team/Project Key.” This Team/Project key will appear in a confirmation screen for that student, a confirmation email, and in that student’s profile when logged into the account.
 - **Sample Team/Project Key:** b965f631-a8a0-4eff-8145-d1698f3618d3.
- The other group members will create their student accounts and enter the **Team/Project Key** for their entry. This will bring up the title and description for their entry that was filled out by the group member who created the entry.

Editing Student Account Information

After logging into your student account, click your name in the top right corner.

- Select **My Profile** from the drop-down menu to edit your personal information, project information, or other registration information. The option to edit your account is only available before February 19, 2021 at 11:01 p.m. (the due date for your project).
- Select **Change Password** to change the password for your account.

Uploading Your Project

Important: History Day projects must be submitted to the regional contest by Friday, February 19th at 11:01 pm.

To submit your project, log in to your student account. Click your name in the top right corner. Select **My Profile**.

- **Documentary Students:** Upload a single PDF of your **Written Materials** (title page, process paper, and annotated bibliography) and insert a shareable **Documentary Link** from Google Drive, OneDrive, or Dropbox. Find full virtual contest guidelines for documentaries at nhda.fyi/DocGuide
- **Exhibit Students:** Upload a single PDF of your **Written Materials** (title page, process paper, annotated bibliography, and exhibit). Find full virtual contest guidelines for exhibits at nhda.fyi/ExhibGuide
- **Paper Students:** Upload a single PDF of your **Paper** (title page, process paper, annotated bibliography, and paper). Find full virtual contest guidelines for papers at nhda.fyi/PaperGuide
- **Performance Students:** Upload a single PDF of your **Written Materials** (title page, process paper, annotated bibliography, and performance companion worksheet) and insert a shareable **Performance Link** from Google Drive, OneDrive, or Dropbox. Find full virtual contest guidelines for performances at nhda.fyi/PerfGuide
- **Website Students:** Insert your NHDWebCentral **Site Key**. Find full virtual contest guidelines for websites at nhda.fyi/WebGuide

You made it! You have completed your registration *and* submitted your project to the contest.

Advancing to the State Contest

If your project takes first, second, or third place at the regional contest, you will advance to the state contest. You will receive an email from your coordinator with a link that takes you to the homepage of the Arkansas Affiliate Contest.

Step 1: Click the **Login** button on the top right of the page. **Do not create a new account.**

Step 2: Use the same username and password that you created for regional contest registration to log in to your Arkansas Affiliate Contest profile.

Step 3: Read the welcome message, “**there are a few things to take care of...**” click the blue **Next** button. Follow the prompts to complete registration.

Step 4: Complete the **Student Permissions and Waivers** section with a parent/guardian. Then, click the blue **Next** button.

Step 5: Click the **Complete first time login** button. This will take you to the main page where you can access your profile.

Step 6: Click on your name in the top right corner of the screen. Select **My Profile**. Please **confirm** that your name, mailing address, phone number, email address, and any category-specific information is complete and accurate. This information is necessary for NHD staff to contact you if an issue arises and to mail you your certificates or medal after the contest. This must be completed by the State Contest registration deadline on **Friday, March 19, 2021**.

Step 7: Please use the same process you followed for the regional contest to upload and/or enter the link for your updated project and written materials. Updated projects must be uploaded to your Arkansas Affiliate Contest profile by **Monday, April 5, 2021 at 11:01 pm**.

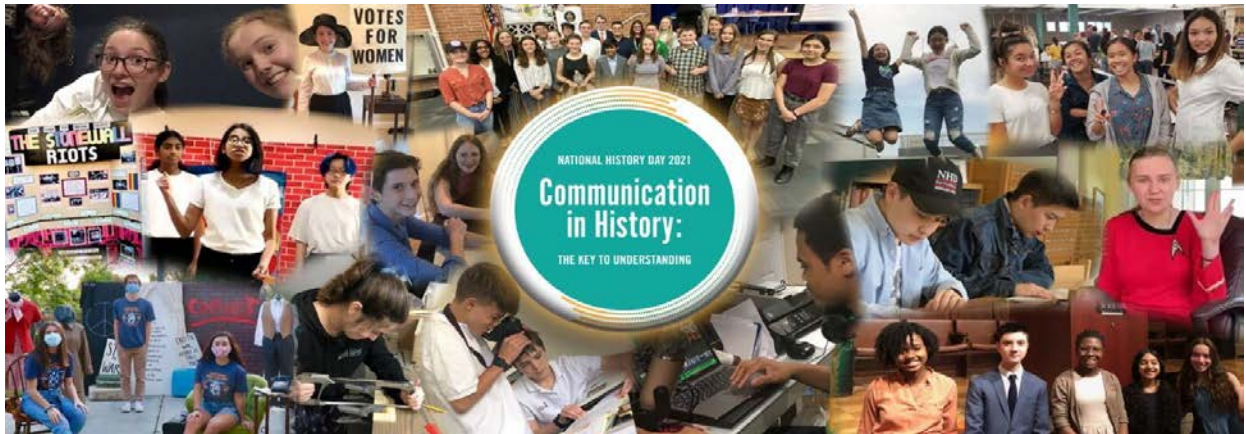
