
#### **Creating a Teacher Account**

**Important:** Teachers must register before their students. Students will not be able to register until their teacher has registered.

Step 1: Go to the <u>Region 8 contest portal</u> (https://ar-rl.nhd.org/)

Step 2: Click Create Account in the toolbar


 Select Teacher from the drop-down menu.



#### **Creating a Teacher Account**

Step 3: Add your name and email.

- Check the box next to "I'm Not a Robot."
- Click the blue Next button.



#### Step 4. Complete the **Teacher's Personal Information** section.

- Your password must be at least 6 characters long. It also must contain upper and lowercase letters.
- Record your username and password.
   Select the blue Save & Continue button.

#### **Creating a Teacher Account**

Step 5: Select your school from the menu.

 If your school does not appear on this list, please contact nhdar@uca.edu with your school name and we will add it!

Select Save & Continue.

Step 6. Complete the Additional Questions.

If a question does not apply to you, enter n/a.

Select Save & Continue.

Step 7. Complete the Teacher's **Permissions** and **Waivers section**. Then, click the blue **Continue** button.

Step 8. Registration is complete! You will receive a registration confirmation email from Zfairs. Check your spam folder if you do not receive the email.

## Logging in to a Teacher Account


Step 1: Go to the Region 8 contest portal:

Step 2: Locate Login in the top right corner.

Step 3: Enter your username and password.

Important: If you forget your username or password, click the white Forgot

## Logging out of a Teacher Account

Step 1: Click your name in the top right corner.

Step 2: Select Logout from the drop-down menu.



### Editing Teacher Account Information

Step 1: Log in to your teacher account.

Step 2: Click your name in the top right corner.

Step 3: Select **My Profile** from the drop-down menu to edit your personal information before registration ends.


Step 4: Select **Change Password** to change the password for your account.


