

## PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY PROGRAM

Prerequisite course work must be completed prior to the January 15<sup>th</sup> application deadline. Prerequisite course work 10 years old or older will not be accepted.

**Freshman Admission:** Maintain at least a 3.5 GPA for all occupational therapy prerequisite course work.

**Regular Admission:** Complete all occupational therapy prerequisite course work with a grade of C or better. Courses taken elsewhere must be equivalent or evaluated and **must be approved in advance**.
