UCA OT — Level II Fieldwork Rotation II: (March 28-June 17, 2022)

Course Description

These courses will provide opportunities for integration and application of academically acquired knowledge in an occupational therapy setting with emphasis on a medical model service delivery, a community-based service delivery, or a rehabilitation model service delivery system. These supervised experiences include the delivery of treatment to individuals with a variety of functional limitations.

Course Objectives for this Fieldwork

Upon completion of this course, the learner will:

- 1. Evaluate patients/clients in occupational performance (self-care, work, play/leisure) and identify deficits and/or potential deficits in performance components.
- 2. Validate evaluation data and interpretation of patient/client performance with individual/family and significant others.
- 3. Plan and implement a treatment program based on evaluation data and client's needs and goals.
- 4. Reassess the patient/client's progress and make the necessary adjustments in the treatment program.
- 5. Address psychosocial factors influencing occupational engagement in a variety of contexts and environments to support the development of client-centered, meaningful, occupation-based outcomes that affect health, well-being, and quality of life, as informed by the Occupational Therapy Practice Framework.
- 6. Demonstrate acceptable documentation skills.
- 7. Communicate effectively with staff, patients/clients, and family.
- 8. Contribute to administrative and supervisory functions in the occupational therapy department.
- 9. Develop appropriate collaborative relationships with other health practitioners and significant others in the practice setting.
- 10. Assume responsibility for professional behavior and growth.
- 11. Engage in independent study on topics relevant to the practice setting.
