- ◆ Commitment to academic excellence.
- Commitment to demonstrate leadership with peers in school and community settings.
- ◆ Commitment to attend a weekend retreat in the summer and all training sessions (September March) during the 2021-2022 school year.
- Ability to pay \$50 enrollment fee (some scholarships available).
