In addition to the twelve hours required, the major is required to take 21 hours (seven courses) of electives. These electives must be distributed in the following ways. For instance, if taking Ethics as a requirement, one is not permitted to count Ethics as an elective but must choose a different course from the Social and Political Philosophy area.) These electives should be carefully chosen, for different ones may be relevant to different goals: graduate school in philosophy, graduate school in religious studies, law school, business, seminary, etc.
