

Subfield Requirements (24 credit hours) – Students must complete twenty-four [24] credit hours of upper-division elective courses, including at least one course (3 credit hours) from each of the five interdisciplinary subfields. In addition, a minimum of 18 of the 24 credit hours should be political science (PSCI) and public administration (PADM) courses. All of the upper-division political science courses in the subfields have prerequisites (e.g. PSCI 1330 is a prerequisite for all upper-division American Government & Politics courses and PSCI 2300 is a prerequisite for all upper-division American Government & Politics courses and PSCI 2300 is a prerequisite for all upper-division International Relations courses). Several of the upper-division elective courses in the subfields, both political science and non-political science, satisfy the UCA Upper-Division Core requirements, which consist of upper-division elective courses in five different areas – Effective Communication [C], Diversity [D], Critical Inquiry [I], Responsible Living [R], and Capstone [Z].
