

Minor in Public Service

16 hours

Students may choose to minor in Public Service (16 credit hours). Students minoring in Public Service are required to complete 10 credit hours of core required PADM courses, three credit hours at the 3000 level or above from the Public and Non-Profit Management issue area, and three credit hours at the 3000 level or above from the Policy Analysis and Advocacy issue area.

Note:

1. PSCI 1330, U.S. Government and Politics [[ACTS](#): PLSC2003], is a prerequisite for all upper-division PSCI and PADM courses. PADM 2310, Introduction to Public Service and Policy, is a prerequisite for all upper-division PADM courses.
