Ready Education

- For Attendance Tracking, is it a requirement to check students through Card Swipe?
 - No. While our first preference is an in-person (ID scanning/ unique QR code scanning with a pair app) attendance tracking method, we do not have a strict requirement as long as attendance is taken.
- For Attendance Tracking, is it a requirement to allow students to check themselves in by scanning an Auto Generated QR Code with their mobile app or phone camera?
 - While it is not a requirement, we would like this option, but it must be reliable. Our current system is not reliable to catch 100% of attendees using this method.
- For Attendance Tracking, is it a requirement to auto re-generate the QR Code to avoid students checking in through the code being shared remotely?
 - This would be useful for departments that utilize a QR code.
- For Email/Social Media Integration/Campus-Wide Communication, is it a requirement to have the ability to dynamically build emails through drag-and-drop?
 - That would be very useful
- For Email/Social Media Integration/Campus-Wide Communication, is it a requirement to allow administrators of the platform to send push notifications to users in the platform through different filters?
 - This would be useful to avoid having to send mass emails.
- For Email/Social Media Integration/Campus-Wide Communication, is it a requirement to have a built-in native 2-way chat functionality for web and mobile, for all users of the platform?
 - This is not a requirement. We would prefer an option to turn this feature on and off, and to grant this permission as we see fit.
- For Email/Social Media Integration/Campus-Wide Communication, is it a requirement to have built-in communities, so students and staff can communicate with each other through posts, likes, and comments?
 - This would be useful.
- For Email/Social Media Integration/Campus-Wide Communication, is it a requirement to have a directory that students can leverage to filter and find other students with similar interests, similar to other social media platforms where users can chat and see other profiles once the connection is accepted?
 - No. Directory information can be useful, especially if users have the option to make their information viewable or to hide it.
- For Easy Online Form Development, is it a requirement to have the ability to build a survey-type form?
 - Yes.
- For Easy Online Form Development, is it a requirement to have the ability to build an election-type form?
 - Yes.

- For Student Organization/Club Registration, is it a requirement to allow students to discover and register themselves in Student Organizations and Clubs of their interest?
 - No. We would prefer the leaders of the club/organization to manage their rosters. A request button would be useful, but an automatic acceptance would not be our preference.
- For the ability to upload all document types, including media files, is it a requirement to have a File Management capability natively built in each Student Organization, Group, and Club?
 - Yes, that would be useful.
- For Self-Contained websites for student clubs/organizations, is it a requirement to have the ability to create public websites through drag-and-drop functionality, where the websites must go through approval to be published?
 - We do not want the approval to be a requirement, but we would like the ability to remove this access if it becomes necessary.
- For Web–based application administration including ability to customize applications in an easy-to-use web form (without need to request changes via technical support), is it a requirement to configure the application through drag-and-drop functionality?
 - Yes
- As part of the ability to build a portfolio/career management, is it a requirement to have a functionality that allows students to book time with advisors and mentors through a native meeting scheduler that integrates with the email platform used on campus to avoid time conflicts?
 - No
- For the ability to create derived or calculated columns in reports, is it a requirement to have a report builder functionality that allows authorized users to filter and select key data points from the system to create reports that can be saved, and data that can be extracted ad-hoc?
 - \circ $\;$ Yes, this would be our preference at the community-wide and organizational level
- Is it a requirement to have an academic integration to pull academic information from UCA's LMS into the web and mobile application?
 - Yes

4. Can you provide clarification for #23 of the requirements: Ability to pull all fields from application for docx, xls, csv, etc. formats. We would like data exports to have the ability to be opened and edited through these systems.
