SPECIAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Psychology majors choose to pursue either a BA or BS degree in psychology

Bachelor of Arts (BA) REQUIREMENT

- _____ FLAN 2300 or higher (most students will need to take the 1310 and 1320 language courses prior to the 2300 course)

Bachelor of Science (BS) REQUIREMENT

- _____ Two courses in math (above Gen Ed level; excluding UNIV 1340, MATH 3351, and MATH 4310) **OR**
- _____ Two courses in a lab science (both courses must be from same department; General education science courses (e.g., BIOL 1400, CHEM 1400, PHYS 1400, and PHYS 1401) cannot be used to satisfy the additional year of science.)

NOTES:

- Psychology majors must complete the requirements for a minor field of study or a second major.
- To ensure fairness, course prerequisite requirements are strictly enforced.
- 40 of the 120 total credits for graduation must be upper division courses (3000 or 4000 level)
- Graduation requires a 2.00 cum GPA, 2.00 major GPA, and 2.00 minor GPA
- You may take up to 4 courses for forgiveness of Ds and Fs (GPA will not include 1st grade)
- You should only request enrollment in a closed PSYC class when the class is necessary for you to graduate on schedule. You must get a note signed by your advisor and then approval from Dr. Gillaspay (Chairperson for the department).
- To register for classes, log into your MyUCA account, select Self-Service tab, select Registration
