## NOTES:

- Psychology majors must complete the requirements for a minor field of study, a second major, or a professional certificate requiring 13 or more credit hours.
- To ensure fairness, course prerequisite requirements are strictly enforced.
- 40 of the 120 total credits for graduation must be upper division courses (3000 or 4000 level)
- Graduation requires a minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA, 2.00 major GPA, and 2.00 minor GPA
- You may re-take courses for forgiveness of Ds and Fs (GPA will not include 1st grade)
- You should only request enrollment in a closed PSYC class when the class is necessary for you to graduate on schedule. Contact your PSYC advisor for assistance with closed courses.
