- I. Completion of a Baccalaureate Degree
- II. Completion of DPT Course Requirements (see below)
- III. Application to the Professional DPT Program also requires a minimum cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 and science GPA (biology, chemistry and physics) GPA of a least 3.0 each based on a 4.0 scale; completion of the Graduate Record Exam (GRE); and completion of 20 hours of required science coursework by October 1.

Successful applicants are invited to an interview in December. A new class will begin study in August. The program is 36 months.
