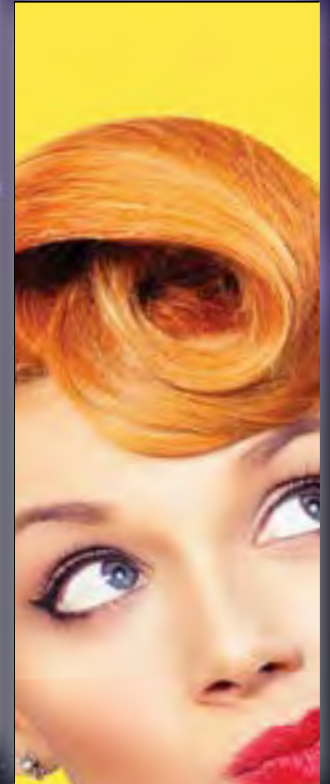

We truly cherish our time with these students and are thrilled to introduce them to performing arts.

We raise 100% of the funds for the Main Stage Series through donors, sponsorships, grants, fundraisers, and benefit performances. We have also recently started an endowment for this program so that we can serve children for generations to come. In fact, 20 percent of all donations will go toward this important project.

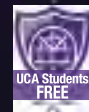

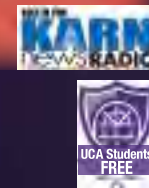

Amy Grant

Friday, September 30, 2022

Conventional wisdom has it that **Amy Grant** put Contemporary Christian Music on the map, becoming the first CCM artist to have a platinum record, the first to hit No. 1 on the Pop charts, and the first to perform at the GRAMMY Awards. Since then, Grant has been strumming her way through a thirty-plus year adventure as a singer-songwriter, author, television host, and speaker. Over the years, she has sold more than 30 million albums world-wide, including three multi-platinum, six platinum, and four gold. Her chart performance has also been consistent throughout her career, boasting six No. 1 hits, 10 "Top 40" Pop singles, 17 "Top 40" Adult Contemporary tracks and multiple Contemporary Christian chart-toppers. In recognition of such success, Grant has received 6 GRAMMY Awards and 26 Dove Awards, a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, and a star on the Music City Walk of Fame. Additionally, she was most recently inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame in Nashville.

Thursday, November 10, 2022

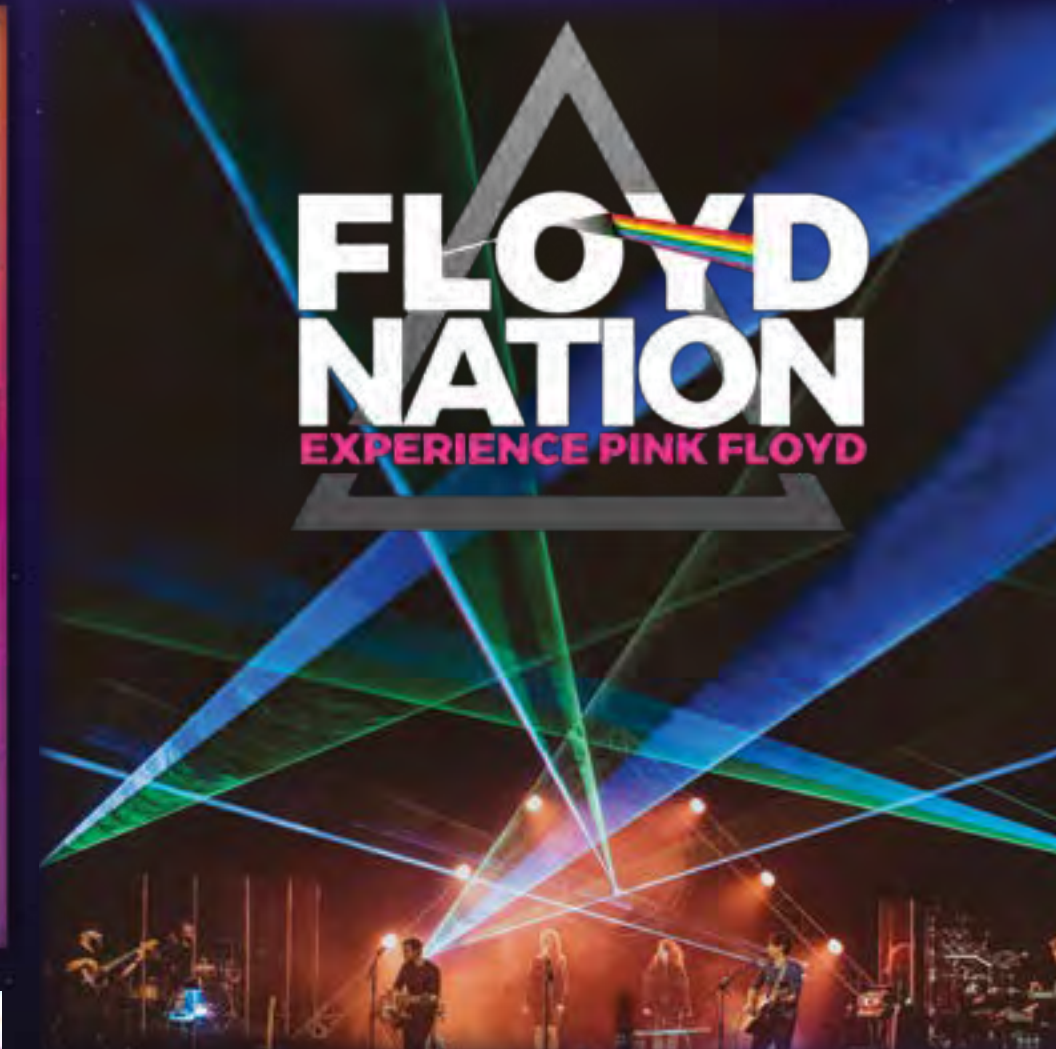
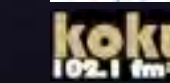
In 1993, **Neal McCoy** broke into the country music scene with back-to-back number 1 singles "No Doubt About It" and "Wink" from his platinum-certified album *No Doubt About It*. His commercial success continued into the late 1990s with two more platinum albums and a gold album, as well as six more Top Ten hits. In all, he has released 15 studio albums including one produced in 2012 by Blake Shelton and Miranda Lambert and his last in 2017, *Neal McCoy's Favorite Hit's* which included two new songs. Neal has been on 17 USO Tours around the world and continues to say it's one of the achievements he's most proud of. He is the recipient of multiple Humanitarian awards from The Academy of Country Music, The country Radio Broadcasters and The Masonic Grand Lodge.

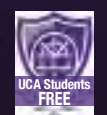

Steve Burns

Steve Burns is an American actor and television host best known as the original host of the long-running children's preschool television program *Blue's Clues* from 1996 until 2002, for which he was nominated for a Daytime Emmy in 2001. After years of being the face of the much-loved *Blue's Clues* series, Steve said his goodbyes to Blue in 2001 and went off to college. In this talk, Steve shares what happened to him after he left the television show. With his heartfelt and open approach that brought him into the spotlight, he candidly talks about the successes and, more importantly, the failures he has experience along the way. 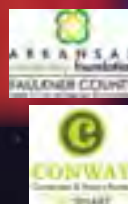

TICKETS, SERVICES & CHILDREN

Due to the nature of the performing arts, all dates, programs, and artists are subject to change without notice. The views and opinions expressed by the artists may not necessarily be shared by Reynolds Performance Hall or the University of Central Arkansas. Refunds are given only in the case of event cancellation. Handling fees are not refundable. Tickets may be exchanged for another event, if available, up to 48 hours prior to the event for which you have tickets. An exchange fee may apply.

Reynolds Performance Hall Box Office is the only authorized agent for ticket sales to Reynolds Performance Hall events. Purchasing tickets through a secondary site or any other seller is at your own risk. Reynolds Performance Hall may not be able to honor tickets purchased through secondary sellers. Should an event be canceled and refunds made available, only tickets purchased through Reynolds Performance Hall (online or in person) will be honored. Any refunds will be made in the amount of the original ticket price (fees not refundable).

All patrons, regardless of age, must have a ticket to enter the auditorium.

To ensure a pleasurable performance for all, Reynolds Performance Hall is accessible to persons with disabilities. Accessible seating for persons with disabilities and a companion are available for all shows on a first-come, first-served basis. Make sure to mention your interest in wheelchair-accessible seating or other accommodations when placing your ticket order. Parking for patrons with disabilities is available in the parking lot west of Reynolds.

Wireless hearing enhancement systems are available free of charge to patrons with hearing impairments. The devices are available on a first-come, first-served basis in the main lobby at the Will Call desk before each performance.

Many of the shows at Reynolds Performance Hall are designed for families and “kid friendly,” some are designated as for “mature audiences”. We make every effort to inform ticket buyers about the suitability of a program for a young person. We encourage parents to enjoy shows with your children and ask that you use your personal judgment when deciding on the appropriateness of a performance for yourself, your children, and other patrons.

Out of respect for other ticket holders, Reynolds reserves the right to have parents remove disruptive children immediately upon request. A monitor is sometimes available in the lobby for patrons to watch the show until the child is ready to go back into the quite atmosphere of the theatre.

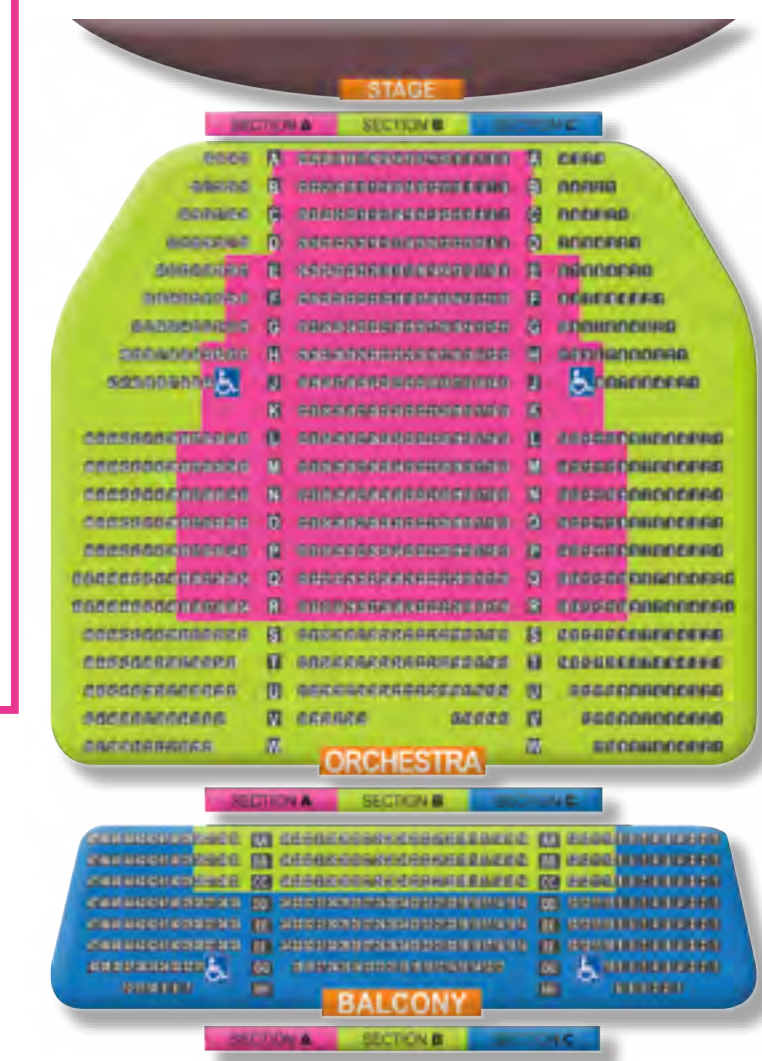
