Widely praised among the greatest singers in the history of rock, Ann's extraordinarily powerful voice has been sending chills down her audience's collective spine for over five decades, earning record sales of more than 35 million, an induction into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, and a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award. "Barracuda," "Crazy on You," and "Magic Man" are among many of the songs Wilson has written.



# MARK CHESNUTT

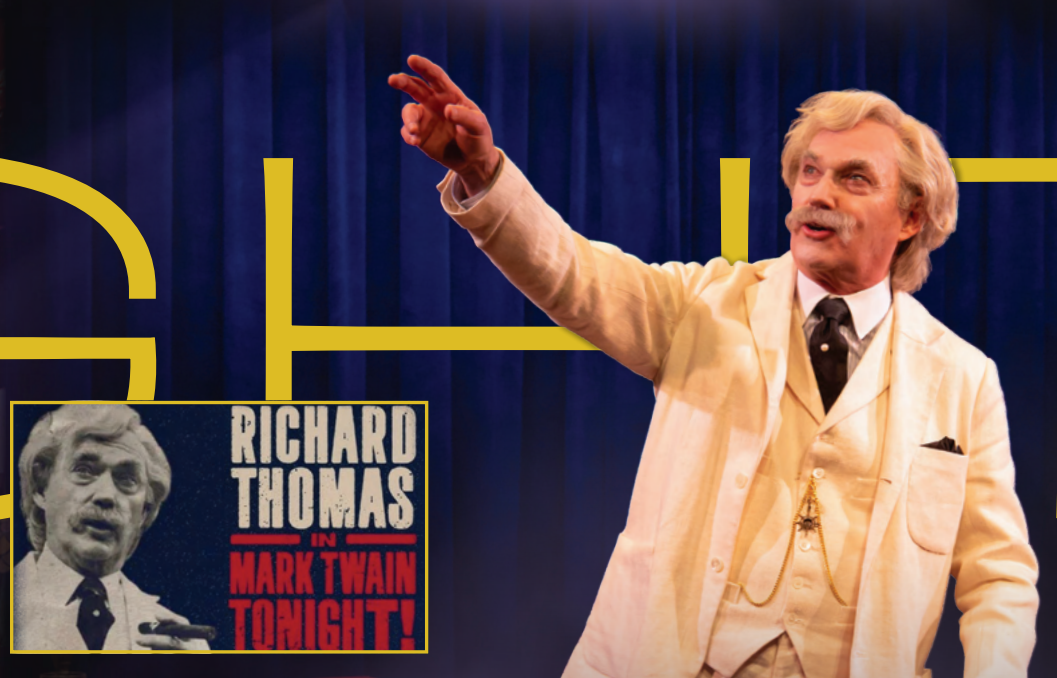

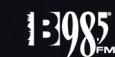




# CELTIC ANGELS CHRISTMAS

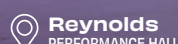
# RICHARD THOMAS IN MARK TWAIN TONIGHT!

Their 1978 smash hit, "Kiss You All Over," spent four weeks at the top of Billboard's pop chart and was used in the 1996 movie *Happy Gilmore* and the 2006 film *Employee of the Month*. During their run on the country charts, Exile had ten No. 1 singles, including "Woke Up In Love" and "Give Me One More Chance." The five original members re-formed in 2008 to perform their classic hits along with new moving music.
