University Scholarship Policy 2020-2021 Academic Scholarship Policy



This policy covers the Future Leaders (2-years), University, Achievement, Excellence, and Presidential Distinguished scholarships.

Eligibility:

- To be eligible for scholarship consideration, students must:
 - Submit required documentation to the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services by December 10, 2019;
 - Be a first-time entering undergraduate;
 - Have a minimum ACT super score of 23 or the SAT equivalent. Qualifying scores must be on a test within the last five years and no later than November 2019;
 - o Have completed <u>all</u> remediation requirements;
 - Meet GPA Requirements:

Future Leaders, University, and Achievement Scholarships

 Minimum 3.25 cumulative high school GPA (on a 4.00 GPA scale) based on the 6th semester high school transcript.

Excellence and Presidential Distinguished Scholarships

- Minimum 3.50 cumulative high school GPA (on a 4.00 scale) based on the 6th semester high school transcript.
- If a student is graduating high school early, a 4th or 5th semester transcript will be considered.
- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- All institutional scholarships are highly competitive and are awarded based on academic performance and available funds.

Deadline:

• Scholarship Deadline: December 10, 2019

Award Requirements:

- Future Leaders scholarships are for the duration of four consecutive semesters or through the completion of a bachelor's degree, whichever occurs first.
- University, Achievement, Excellence, and Presidential Distinguished scholarships are for the duration of eight consecutive semesters or through the completion of a bachelor's degree, whichever occurs first.
- Student must be enrolled in a minimum of 15 UCA undergraduate credit hours as of the 8th class day each semester during the term of their scholarship.
- Students must maintain good academic standing as defined by the current Undergraduate Bulletin.
- The scholarship is awarded for the Fall and Spring semesters only.

Renewal Requirements:

- To renew the scholarship, students must:
 - Year one (Fall to Spring)
 - Earn a minimum of 12 UCA undergraduate credit hours with a minimum 2.50 (Future Leaders, University) or 2.75 (Achievement, Excellence, Presidential Distinguished) UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA.
 - Year one (Spring to Fall)
 - Earn a minimum of 27 UCA undergraduate credit hours (Fall/Spring combined) with a minimum 3.00 (Future Leaders, University) or 3.25 (Achievement, Excellence, Presidential Distinguished) UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA.



- Year two and after (Fall to Spring)
 - Earn a minimum of 12 UCA undergraduate credit hours with a minimum 3.00 (Future Leaders, University) or 3.25 (Achievement, Excellence, Presidential Distinguished) UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA.
- Year two and after (Spring to Fall)
 Earn a minimum of 30 UCA undergraduate credit hours (Fall/Spring combined) with a minimum 3.00 (University) or 3.25 (Achievement, Excellence, Presidential Distinguished) UCA cumulative undergraduate GPA.
- If requirements have been completed at the end of the Spring semester, the scholarship will renew at that time.
- If requirements are not completed at the end of the Spring semester then UCA summer term hours and GPA will be considered in the renewal process.
- Academic performance will be evaluated at the end of the Summer I term for students who do not meet requirements after the Spring semester. If requirements have been completed at the end of the Summer I term, the scholarship will renew at that time.
- Academic performance will be evaluated at the end of the Summer II term for students who do not meet requirements after the Summer I term. If requirements have been completed at the end of the Summer II term, the scholarship will renew at that time.
- Scholarship renewal criterion is based on UCA credit hours only.
- Any student who earns an incomplete (X) grade(s) must have the grade(s) resolved according to the
 <u>University Scholarship Policy Incomplete Grades</u> and meet renewal requirements for the scholarship
 to renew. Otherwise, an exception request must be submitted in accordance with the Exception
 Policy.

Disclosures:

- There will be no reinstatement of a lost scholarship.
- Costs associated with Summer Courses are not covered by academic scholarships.
- The hours and grades/credits associated with Graduate, Department of Student Transitions, and Intensive English Program courses are not considered in renewal or disbursement of academic scholarships.
- Academic scholarships will only apply to charges for in-state tuition, room/board, and mandatory fees
 directly assessed by the University except for approved programs through the Office of Study Abroad.
 For such programs, the scholarship may be applied only to actual tuition and mandatory fees
 assessed.
- Students awarded the Achievement, Excellence, or Presidential Distinguished scholarship must live in University housing to receive the housing award and therefore the annual total award.
