

WHAT 1:

Executive Functioning Practice (2:15-2:45) (no extra fee charged)

<u>Executive function helps students</u> <u>focus, plan, periodize, work toward</u> <u>goals, and self-regulate behaviors.</u>

Executive function lesson units will provide basics about cognitive abilities needed to control thoughts, emotions, and actions. We will integrate these activities to reading and writing practices.

WHAT 2:

Literacy Intervention (2:45-4:15)

Using evidence-based intervention founded upon the principles of Orton-Gillingham, Read to Succeed! will provide training in:

- Sound symbol association
- Phonological awareness
- · Syllable Instruction
- Oral Reading fluency
- Written text comprehension
