- Minutes from the March meeting were approved.
- Shelley Mehl UCA Foundation
 - o Reviewed what the Foundation is and what its relationship is with the University
 - Completely separate board of directors
 - Members serve 3-year terms
 - Board elects its own members
 - Ex-officio members:
 - Shelley is one because of her role as the President of the UCA Foundation
 - o President of the University
 - o Representative from the Alumni Association
 - Representative from UCA Board of Trustees
 - 501c3 non-profit
 - Mission is to support UCA / operate for UCA's benefit
 - Reviewed handouts
 - Standing committee list
 - Memorandum of Understanding between the Foundation and the University –
 lays out who is responsible for what and what each party does
 - Information provided to the UCA Board of Trustees at the March retreat (summary information)
 - Foundation is in the beginning stages of implementing its own Strategic Plan that will complement UCA's Strategic Plan.
 - Plan includes how they will move from being interdependent to independent over the next 10 years
 - Becoming more financially independent (although it is common/typical for a university to pay for development activities)

- Buffalo Alumni Hall is owned by the Foundation by leased by UCA (through Arkansas Building Authority / "ABA")
- O Donors decide where and how their donations are used and also whether the money goes to the University or the Foundation.
 - Donors have meetings with Foundation employees to ensure that they have a mutually clear understanding of how the donors wish to have their funds used. The bottom line is that it is the donor's decision how their funds are used.
 - If a donor makes an unrestricted gift, the University or Foundation boards decide how to use it. Unrestricted gifts are typically spent within a year
 - With endowments, the principal is never spent the interest or other earnings are what is used each year for awards
 - Programmatic funds are restricted by the donors
 - These funds are to be used strictly for support of a specific department.
 - The fund director is the one who decides how the money is spent
 - If a department or program has a Foundation fund, they can use it to pay for things that fall outside the realm of the Strategic Plan, but these expenditures must still be approved through the departments up through the approval chain.
- o In FY12, \$612,000 was awarded in Foundation scholarships, and direct expense reimbursements to the University were just over \$1 million.
- Shelley will provide a copy of the Foundation's quarterly financial statement to the library so that interested parties can access it.

 - Exhibit 1 Unrestricted/Unallocated Cash Balance (line chart)
 - This is the cash that is available to support the budget.
 - Shows in visual form where our balance is from month to month
 - Currently about \$39.5 million
 - Cash will steadily decrease between now and 6/30

- o Exhibit 3 Operating Summary
 - Shows where we are this year as compared to the same time last year and projects our year-end balance based on a formula. As the end of the year gets closer, the projection becomes more accurate.
- o Financial Report Card
 - Created for the Higher Learning Commission (HLC)
 - One-page report that shows where we are financially
 - Ratios as they relate to the Composite Financial Index (CFI), which is the most important number to the HLC
 - The range given is self-imposed the BOT decides where they want us to be
- o Do not currently know what our proposed budget for FY14 will be.
