## Student Success & Retention Council August 16, 2018

The Student Success and Retention Council (SSRC) met in regular session at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 16, 2018. - 1. P. Poulter welcomed the group. In preparation for today's meeting, she reviewed the Student Success and Retention Plan, focusing on the Guiding Principles. She inquired about the assessment of the plan's goals.
  - The Plan is a very aspirational document that has a lot of moving parts. The group needs to track the progress of the Plan so that they can assess whether the goals are being met.
- 2. The SSRC members that are also members of the Front-Line Working Group discussed the initiatives that they worked on over the summer, including communications with the students about why they had not yet registered. They will share some of the feedback from those students at a future meeting.

The position will be that of an Associate Vice President whose priority will be student success and managing enrollment, and it will report directly to the Provost. Once the position has been filled, those departments within the division of Enrollment Services will be Admissions, Academic Advising, Office of the Registrar, and Student Financial Aid.
