I. Call to Order

A. Vice President Graybeal called Staff Senate to order at 10:00 am in Wingo Hall 315.

II. Guest Presenter

- A. Dr. Angela Webster presented on new developments from Institutional Diversity.
 - 1. Ericka Gutierrez is the new Hispanic/Latino Outreach Initiatives Coordinator in Institutional Diversity. There has been a need for a full-time coordinator due to the increase in Hispanic/Latino students.
 - 2. The department is proposing a name change from "Institutional Diversity" to "Institutional Diversity and Inclusion."
 - 3. With the next upgrade of Banner, UCA's system will have the capacity to support a "preferred name" field (for example, "Bill" might be preferred versus "William"). This is subject to approval from the Banner Team.
 - 4. New committees within Institutional Diversity this year include Black Men's Experience at UCA Committee and the Political and Religious Acceptance Committee.
 - 5. Each department is asked to assist with the Diversity Strategic Plan.

- 6. The Conversations about Diversity event will be held in Student Center 225 on November 9, 2017 during X-period.
- 7. Question (from Senator Davidson): Since the last Higher Learning Commission (HLC) visit, are there any recommendations from them? Answer: We have had no diversity-related citations from the HLC, but there is still a need for more minority and historically-underrepresented faculty. The outcomes have not changed significantly, as minority faculty members have been leaving at roughly the same rate as they were being hired.
