## I. Call to Order

- A. President Ruud called the meeting to order at 10:09am.

## **IV.** Officer Reports

- A. President, Jennifer Ruud
  - 1. Volunteer Hours
    - a) UCA will now close campus on the last two working days of the calendar year. Staff no longer need to use leave time (or accrued volunteer hours from Staff Senate) for those days.
    - b) Starting September 1st, employees who volunteer for Staff Senate events can now earn up to 16 hours of leave time each calendar year that can be used anytime during the year, subject to supervisor approval.
      - Volunteer leave balances can never exceed 16 hours. An employee who accrues but does not take the 16 hours within the calendar year can carry over up to 16 hours for the next year
      - (2) Any time earned prior to September 1st, 2023 can be used (with supervisor approval) by December 31st of this year. Any unused hours over 16 will be forfeited for the upcoming year.
    - c) Staff Senate is in discussion about other incentives staff can earn for volunteering.
  - 2. Reynolds Update
    - a) Staff Senate will be compensated \$200 per show, an increase from the previous rate of \$135 per show.
    - b) Staff Senate will be accepting volunteers for the shows at Reynolds and Windgate.
