### **IV.** Officer Reports

- A. President, Jennifer Ruud
  - 1. Board Meeting

  - 2. Health Insurance Premiums
    - a) There have been some concerns voiced about the 10% increase to insurance premiums. As we receive those concerns, the executive team will pass them forward.
  - 3. The UCA Staff Senate received a shoutout in a session presented by Florida International University at the national NACADA conference on mental health for staff at universities for the recent W(h)ine and Cheese outreach initiative. There were 3000 people at the conference!

  - 1. Sent out notification of the vacancy for Finance and Administration senator, but there was no interest. There will be another email sent to all staff who may be interested in participating as a senator.

  - 1. Staff Senate's budget looks healthy as much has not been spent yet.
  - 2. Staff Senate has received \$10,000 from the President's office for the annual spring social event.

- D. Secretary, Veneta Fricks
  - 1. Committee chairs need to check their respective committee pages to see if updates are needed.
