I. Call to Order

- A. President Ruud called the meeting to order at 10:00am.
- **II. Approval of the Minutes of previous meeting** A. 9/13/23 minutes approved via email and are posted to the Staff Senate website.

III. Guest Speakers

- A. Kevin
 - 1. Project Updates
 - a) Schichtl Renovation (March 2024 Project Completion Estimate)
 - (1) All brand new air quality/HVAC systems are being placed throughout the building.
 - (2) The Center for Global Learning and Engagement and the Honors College will be moving into Schichtl. The renovation includes constructing office spaces and updating classroom spaces.
 - b) McAlister (6-8 weeks Project Completion Estimate)
 - (1) Roof replacement happened last year.
 - (2) Fan coil units, air handlers, piping insulation, encapsulation of crawl spaces, and air quality improvements going on now.
 - (3) ANCRC grant helped with the lobby expansion to include new flooring and bathroom refresh.
 - (4) Wheelchair ramp on the south side of the building.
 - c) Burdick (2025 Project Completion Estimate)
 - (1) Working with insurance for the reimbursement from the fire. The space where 1907 Bread Co. was will be transformed into office spaces for IT.
 - d) Estes Stadium (Project Completed)



- (1) The concourse area to the chairback seats have been waterproofed to stop leaking into the football athletic offices and locker rooms. It also looks nicer.
- e) Snow Fine Arts (Project Beginning Spring 2024)
 - (1) Project will begin Spring 2024 to work on air quality. This will impact class locations. Physical Plant is working with the Provost's office to organize class locations.
- f) Student Success and Veterans Resource Center (99% Completed)
 - (1) Located in the old chapel on Donaghey and Bruce.
 - (2) Staff are beginning to move offices to the new space. Moves will continue through November 2023.
- g) The Fountain
 - (1) The fountain is off because someone soaped it. The soap is harsh on the pumps, and new ones had to be ordered. Due to the uniqueness of the pump parts, they had to be specially ordered. The expected ship date from overseas is 11/16/23, and then it will take some time for installation.
- 2. Updated PP Website
 - a) The Physical Plant website has been updated to make it more user friendly and now matches the other UCA sites. Residential floor plans are password protected for safety, and employees must use their UCA credentials to view them. See the new Physical Plant website here: <u>https://uca.edu/physicalplant/</u>
- 3. PP Uniform
 - a) Physical Plant staff have new uniforms. Grounds employees have new visible shirts where they can be seen from the streets for safety. Technicians have button down shirts. All employees have jackets that will be worn during the cooler weather.
- 4. Custodial Contracting
 - a) Custodial department has been struggling to maintain employees. The custodial services were struggling to provide quality services to the campus, so an RFP was conducted to select a custodial vendor. There are no intentions to terminate any custodial employees. There have been shifts in building assignments to provide more custodians in buildings that need more attention, and the contractors are currently working on 4 of the buildings. The RFP is for 4 years, but it is renewable annually.
 - b) Applications are still live for housing custodians, but not the general campus buildings.
- 5. S/D Parking Lot (6-8 weeks Project Completion Estimate)
 - a) The parking lot is currently being undercut and filled to remediate the soil conditions.
 - b) There will be approximately 77 spaces. 1 row of the lot to the west side (close to Conway Hall) will be faculty/staff parking. The



middle double row will be white spaces for general parking. The row closest to the Student Center will be metered and ADA parking. How many of each space will be determined by executive staff.

- 6. WH Parking Lot
 - a) Western Heights behind the Conway Corp Center for Sciences has been demolished.
 - b) Approximately 50 concrete parking spots will be placed there. Spaces have not been allocated yet.
- 7. Transportation
 - a) There are 3 over the road drivers needed who have a CDL license with passenger endorsement. The positions will be posted soon.
 - b) New shuttle route will start next week to accommodate students traveling from Snow Fine Arts to Windgate. See the orange shuttle route and all others here: http://www.universityofcentralarkansas.ridesystems.net/routes/11/s

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- 8. Elizabeth House
 - a) There was an ice maker leak in the house that damaged the flooring and cabinets. It is still offline, but the work will begin soon.

 - 1. Insurance premiums will increase by 10%. This percentage increase is lower than other companies (15%) that are not self-funded.
 - 2. The deductible and out of pocket cost are both going up by \$500. UCA will still pay 74% of the claim costs.
 - 3. The discounts for the family health plan for which two UCA employees together on a plan get significant discounts will be going away. The plan discount will remain in effect, but new employees will not receive the discount.
 - 4. The GAP plan will remain.
