I. Call to Order

- A. President Ables called the meeting to order at 10:00 am.

- A. President, Whit Ables
 - 1. General structure of the meeting for anyone who is new.  - Edge Apartment Contract. Approx. 96 beds for 24-25 year and have the option to get the same amount for 25-26 year just because of the enrollment. We are at 108%, so we needed more beds for upperclassmen. It amounts to about 1.5 million if both years are excercised. The beginning term is August 24 and ending term May 25. It is a good sign that we don't have enough housing and hope to have more good news.
