The exception is self pay insurance does not have to cover it. So that is a loop hole so our insurance does not have to cover it. Even people on Medicaid can get bariatric surgery. We work and also pay for our insurance. Maybe if we had better coverage people would be inclined to pay more for our premiums. I'm certain I am not the only staff member who feels this way."
