Athletic	\$ 20.00	Supports the UCA Athletic Department by funding travel, athletic scholarships, employee salaries, and general operations.
Student Center/Recreation	\$ 4.25	Funds upkeep and repair of the Student Center, as well as custodial and student support salaries.
Facilities Fee	\$ 23.75	Helps pay off bonds used to build or renovate buildings around campus.
HPER	\$ 9.12	\$8.62 of this fee funds HPER Center operations. \$0.50 of this fee funds the operation and maintenance of the Farris Intramural fields.
Fine/Performing Arts	\$ 4.00	Funds Baum Gallery, Reynolds Performance Hall, performances in Snow Fine Arts, the Artist in Residence series, and Black Box Student Gallery.
Cooperative Education	\$ 0.50	Funds special programs for students to develop skills and career goals.
Technology	\$ 18.00	Funds IT Department salaries and computer programs, development, and maintenance
Library	\$ 3.00	Funds library improvements, remodeling, online databases, and various projects.

Entering freshmen must have a minimum 2.5 high school GPA (on a 4.00 scale) ii. Undergraduate transfer students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA (on a 4.00 scale) on prior undergraduate coursework iii. Graduate students must have a minimum 2.7 undergraduate GPA (on a 4.00 scale), a 3.0 undergraduate GPA in the last 60 credit hours, or a 3.0 graduate GPA on any coursework taken at another institution <p>Students not meeting the above may qualify based upon a successful admissions appeal or admission pursuant to other University requirements.</p>
