Being a successful college student requires different skills than you needed in high school. Most first-year students quickly realize they aren't as prepared to succeed in college as they thought. UCA's **Summer Start** program will help you learn what you need to succeed before you even begin your first semester. Commit yourself to our programs of intensive skills and content development, and your grades will thank you. YOU will thank you!

The Summer Start program is optional, but students who participate in Summer Start begin their first year at UCA with greater confidence and improved academic skills. You even have the choice of living on campus or commuting during the program.

College Credit Programs - July 8th - August 9th

- **Chem4Success:** Complete CHEM 1301 and a UCA Core course. Financial aid eligible. Recommended review for students enrolled in college-level chemistry in the fall.
- **Math4Success:** Complete MATH 1390 and a UCA Core course. Financial aid eligible. Recommended for students needing College Algebra prior to enrolling in chemistry or business courses in the fall.

One-Week College Prep Programs - August 11th-16th

All of our one-week Summer Start programs will help you improve your study habits, learn to manage your time, explore the campus and meet staff, faculty, and other students.

You choose your focus!

Bear Leadership Experience: This program is intended to give students who will be living and learning in UCA's residential colleges or participating in Minton Commuter College a chance to develop their leadership skills before the semester even begins.

Math Academy: This program allows you to prepare for success in College Algebra. Students taking Foundations of College Algebra in the Fall may re-test and possibly place out of the developmental requirement at the end of the program. (Recommended Math ACT 15-21)

Read/Write for Success: This program prepares you for successful college writing in all of your classes. Students taking Foundations of Literacy in the Fall may re-test and possibly place out of the developmental requirement at the end of the program. (Recommended English or Reading ACT 15-21)
