- Limit your enrollment hours.
- Complete weekly mandatory study hours in the library.

How do you apply?

Meet with Mr. Marvin Williams to be accepted into the UCAN Program. He will accept walk-ins in the Academic Advising Center (Harrin Hall) from Jan. 4-12 (Weekend not included.) Please bring your completed application and the UCAN contract with you to your interview appointment! Sign in at the front desk when you arrive. Interviews will be conducted on a first come first served basis from 8:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

You will not be able to make changes to your schedule or meet with your advisor for registration until you have met with Mr. Williams and been accepted into the UCAN program. If you are accepted into the program, you will be enrolled in the UCAN seminar for the summer semester, unless you have flags (library, student accounts, UCAPD) on your account that prevent registration.
