TRANSFER ADMISSION PROCESS

We encourage students to apply early to ensure themselves the opportunity to start the housing and financial aid processes. Please follow these important steps:

Create an account and submit an online undergraduate application at **uca.edu/admissions/apply**.

Request that official transcripts from all previously attended colleges or universities, including those where high school concurrent credit was earned, be sent to the Office of Admissions.

Note: A minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA on all transfer coursework is required for admission consideration.

- Submit proof of two MMR shots or proper exemptions from the Arkansas Department of Health prior to registration. Students born before Jan. 1, 1957, are exempt from this requirement.
- Students with less than 24 earned credit hours at the time of application must submit an official high school transcript or GED and official ACT/SAT test scores that meet minimum freshman requirements, including:
 - 2.5 high school GPA
 - 17 ACT composite/930 SAT total
 - Minimum 15 ACT/SAT equivalent required for all subject sub-scores

Applications are processed on a rolling basis throughout the year. It usually takes two weeks to process your application once all required materials are received. REQUIREMENTS

- Students must have been enrolled at an accredited college/university within the **prior** academic year.
- Students must be seeking their first bachelor's degree.
- Students must have completed all remediation requirements.
- Students must have earned a minimum of 27 and no more than 75 undergraduate semester credit hours from an accredited college/university with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA. Credit hours earned and cumulative GPA for scholarship consideration will be based only on courses completed per official transcripts on file as of the scholarship deadline.
- Students must have been enrolled at least one semester as a full-time student (12+ semester hours) at an accredited college/university.

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SPRING 2025 DEADLINE: DEC. 12, 2024

FALL 2025 DEADLINE: JUNE 13, 2025

* Admission application and all other required documents must be received by the Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services and meet minimum scholarship requirements by the deadline. Please see the Transfer Scholarship Policy at **uca.edu/scholarships** for all scholarship information.
