

## SAMPLE DEGREE PLAN

### Bachelor of Arts, Art, Art Education

This degree program requires a total of **120 credit hours (CH)**, including **38 credit hours of the lower-division (LD) UCA Core** and **40 credit hours of upper-division (3000- and 4000-level) courses**.
