

## SAMPLE DEGREE PLAN

### Bachelor of Arts, Modern Languages, French, Teacher Education

This degree program requires a total of **120** credit hours (CH), including **38** credit hours of the lower-division (LD) UCA Core and **40** credit hours of upper-division (3000- and 4000-level) courses.
