

## SAMPLE DEGREE PLAN

### Bachelor of Arts, History

This degree program requires a total of **120 credit hours (CH)**, including **38 credit hours** of the lower-division (LD) UCA Core and **40 credit hours** of upper-division (3000- and 4000-level) courses. This sample degree plan demonstrates how a first-time entering freshman with no college credit can earn the degree in eight semesters. The upper-division UCA Core must be met using major, minor, or general elective courses.
