The Washington Center (TWC) Academic Internship Program

The TWC Academic Internship Program is divided into three components (internship, academic course, and career preparation). All UCA participants must be involved in all three components. To participate in the program, UCA students must enroll in twelve UCA credit hours (fall/spring) or nine UCA credit hours (summer) during the term of the program. The UCA courses are typically internship, independent study, seminar, or other similar (experiential learning) courses that are offered by departments at UCA. Each UCA applicant should schedule a meeting with their department (major or minor) academic advisor and/or department internship coordinator to discuss the UCA course options. Listed below are the three components of the TWC program and spaces for the UCA courses/instructors for each component.
