Eight Required Core Courses (22 hours)

LING 2320 Introduction to Language and Linguistics (Fall, Spring) Prerequisite: WRTG 1310 or HONC 1310

LING 2350 World Languages (Fall, Spring, Summer on demand) [Core: I HUM]

LING 3305 Morphology (Spring) Prerequisite: LING 2320 or LING 2350

LING 3325 Sociolinguistics (Fall) [Core: D, R]

LING 4345 Syntax (Spring) Prerequisites: LING 2320, 2350 & 3 LING upper-division hours

LING 4350 Phonology (Fall) Prerequisites: LING 2320, 2350 & 3 LING upper-division hours

LING 4110 Capstone in Linguistics (F,S) [Core: Z] Prerequisite: 24 hours in the major or 12 hours of LING or WLAN courses for non-majors.

Choose One:

LING 3315 Semantics (Spring) or LING 4305 Cognitive Linguistics (Fall) [Core: I]

Related Course Requirement: Any CHIN, FREN, GERM, JAPN, or SPAN course at the 2000 level or higher

Or Option Two

Courses in **two** different languages where one language **must** be Japanese or Chinese, as follows: One of SPAN 1320, FREN 1320, GERM 1320, JAPN 1320, or CHIN 1420; or higher **and in a different language than above**, one of SPAN 1310, FREN 1310, GERM 1310, JAPN 1310, or CHIN 1410; or higher.

Track One: Language (15 hours)

Option One: 15 hours in one language (Spanish, French, German, or Chinese) at the 2000 level and above; must include at least one 3000 level course.

Option Two: Nine hours in Chinese or Japanese; **and** six hours in a second language: Chinese, French, German, Japanese, or Spanish

Choose Two Courses

LING 3310 World Englishes (Spring) Prerequisite: LING 2320

LING 4320 Grammatical Structures (Fall) Prerequisite: LING 2320 or ENGL 3315

LING 4330 Educational Linguistics [Core: C] (Spring) Prerequisite: WRTG 2320, ENGL 1320, or HONC 1320

Track Three: Computer Science (15 hours)

CSCI 1470 Computer Science I (prerequisite: MATH 1390)

CSCI 1480 Computer Science II (prerequisite: C or better in CSCI 1470)

CSCI 2320 Data Structures (prerequisite: CSCI 1480)

Choose any CSCI courses at the 2000 level or above to complete the 15 hours.
